




Revelation: Time, the Day of the Lord, and Eternity

	Eternity Before the Day of The Lord	Time: repentance and turning to the Lord	The Day of the Lord	Eternity After the Day of the Lord
Chapter 1		Jesus appears to John. His appearance is glorious and frightening yet John is told not to fear. Jesus tells John to write the things that He reveals - those that are and those that are to take place afterwards.		
Chapters 2 and 3		Jesus exhorts His Church to repent before the day of His return. These are words for us to live by until He returns.		
Chapter 4	Vision of the throne of God in Heaven. The 24 elders and 4 living creatures worship Him without ceasing.			
Chapter 5	Jesus is revealed as the One who is worthy to ransom people for God. To Him belongs blessing, honor, glory and might forever and ever.			
Chapter 6:1-11		The Lamb opens five of the seven seals. There is war and scarcity of resources. 1/4 of the earth falls to war, famine, pestilence and wild beasts. The saints will be put to death.		
Chapter 6:12-17			The sixth seal. The day of wrath in which everyone seeks to hide themselves from Jesus	
Chapter 7:1-8		144,000 of Israel sealed. (See Ephesians 1:13; Romans 11:11-27; Luke 21:24) The times of the Gentiles fulfilled?		
Chapter 7:9-17	The multitude from every nation coming out of the great tribulation before the throne of God, serving Him in His temple night and day.

Chapter 8:1-4		The Lamb opens the seventh seal, the prayers of the saints are offered on the alter. Seven trumpets given to seven angels.		
Chapter 8:5			The prayers of the saints answered; thunder, rumblings, lightning, earthquake.	
Chapter 8:6-9:21		Six trumpets blown: 1/3 of vegetation, the sea, rivers, and light destroyed, the unrepentant tormented for five months, 1/3 of mankind killed; those left living still do not repent.		
Chapter 10		The promise that the mystery of God would be fulfilled in the days of the seventh trumpet call.		
Chapter 11:1-14		The two witnesses giving prophetic warning, plagues, foreshadowing of God's victory for His witnesses.		
Chapter 11:15-19			The seventh trumpet: The Lord returns!	
Chapter 12	Satan rebels and is thrown from Heaven to the earth. His time is short and he is filled with wrath yet he has been defeated. He is making war on the offspring of Jesus yet they will conquer him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony.			
Chapter 13		The first and second beast and its image. It makes war against and conquers those who keep the commandments of God and hold to the testimony of Jesus. The saints taken captive and slain. A call for endurance. All whose names are not written in the Lamb's book will worship the beast and marvel at its signs. It demands worship and controls all economies.	 <p>"Here is a call for the endurance and faith of the saints!"</p>	
Chapter 14:1-5			 <p>The Lamb and those who He has redeemed; they follow Him wherever He goes.</p>	
Chapter 14:6-13		Prophetic warnings from three angels, a call for endurance and faith, and the promise of blessing to those who die in the Lord.	 <p>"Here is a call for the endurance and faith of the saints!"</p>

Chapter 14:14-20			The Lord executes His judgment and wrath on the earth.	
Chapter 15:1		Seven angels with seven plagues which will finish the wrath of God.		
Chapter 15:2-4		Vision of those who had conquered the beast, its image, and the number of its name, singing the song of Moses and the song of the Lamb.		
Chapter 15:5-8		The seven angels with the seven plagues sent out. No one permitted in the sanctuary until the plagues were finished.		
Chapter 16:1-9		The first four bowls of wrath: painful sores on those who bear the mark of the beast, every living thing in the sea killed, rivers and springs turn to blood, scorching heat and fire. People curse God and do not give him glory or repent.		
Chapter 16:10-11		The fifth bowl of wrath. The kingdom of the beast is thrown into darkness. People gnaw their tongues in anguish. Still they continue to curse God and do not repent of their deeds.		
Chapter 16:12-16		The sixth bowl of wrath. The way is prepared for the kings of the east. The kings of the whole world are assembled for battle at Armageddon to take place on the Day of God the Almighty. Jesus reminds His people of His blessing and exhorts them to stay awake and promises that He is coming soon!		
Chapter 16:17-21			The seventh bowl of wrath. "It is done!", lightning, thunder, rumblings, a great earthquake, islands flee, mountains vanish, 100 lb. hailstones, people curse God for the hail.	
Chapter 17:1-18		Historical overview of Babylon and the kingdoms of the beast. The last 10 kings on earth give the beast their authority and they will make war on the Lamb. The Lamb will conquer them, for he is the Lord of lords and King of kings.

Chapter 18	Judgment and destruction pronounced over Babylon.			
Chapter 19:1-4	Heaven rejoices over God's judgment of Babylon and avenging the blood of the saints.			
Chapter 19:5-10	Heaven continues to rejoice as anticipation builds over the marriage of the Lamb to His Bride			
Chapter 19:11-21			Jesus returns to judge and make war. The beast and kings of the earth and their armies gather for war. The beast and false prophet are thrown into the lake of fire and all others are slain with the sword coming from Jesus' mouth.	
Chapter 20:1-4,6		The age of the Church: Satan bound for 1,000 years to prevent him from deceiving the nations any longer. The gospel delivered to the gentiles and many brought to life in Jesus Christ (first resurrection); they reign with Him, the second death has no power over them and they will be priests of God and of Christ.		
Chapter 20:5,7-10		Satan released from his prison. He will come out and deceive the whole world and gather all the nations, Gog and Magog, to war against the Lamb. Fire from Heaven consumes them and the devil is thrown into the lake of fire where the beast and false prophet were, they are tormented day and night		
Chapter 20:11-15			A great white throne, earth and sky vanish as there is no longer any place for them. The dead are judged according to what they have done. All whose names are not found in the Lamb's book of life are thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

Chapter 21:1-4			The first heaven and first earth are passed away and a new heaven and a new earth appears. God announces that His dwelling place is now with man. He will dwell with them, they will be His people and He will be their God. He will wipe every tear from every eye; death, mourning, crying, and pain will be no more - they have passed away.	
Chapter 21:5-8			The Lamb declares that He is making all things new and assuredly declares, "It is done!". The heritage of those who have conquered is declared as well as the portion of those who did not.	
Chapter 21:9-27			The New Jerusalem. There is no temple for its temple is the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb. The glory of God gives its light and there will be no night there. Sin and death will never enter the City.	
Chapter 22:1-5			There is a river of the water of life that flows from the throne of God and of the Lamb through the middle of the city. The servants of God and the Lamb will worship Him forever. They will see Him face to face, His name will be on their foreheads. Night will be no more. They will need no light of lamp or sun because the Lord God will be their light. They will reign forever and ever.	
Chapter 22:6-21			Jesus declares the truth of these words and assures us that He is coming soon. He promises blessing for the one who keeps the words of this prophecy. John is also instructed not to seal up the words of this prophecy (compare Daniel 12:4) because the time is near! Jesus also warns us not to add or remove anything to this book.
